ENTRIES

CLASSES

In accordance to the Article 2 of the BMU Regulations for 2011 the classes are:

SP JUNIOR	the motorcycles in this class must be homologated by the Manufacturer. (bike capacity up to 170cc 2strokes and 250cc 4strokes) min.10 - max. 18 years; for women riders there is no age limit
Supersport 600cc (SSP 600)	from 401 cc to 600 cc, fourstroke, four cylinder from 550cc to 675cc, three cylinder from 601 cc to 750 cc, fourstroke, two cylinder
Superstock 1000cc (SST 1000)	from 601 cc to 1000 cc, fourstroke, four cylinder from 601 cc to 1200 cc, fourstroke, two cylinder
Superbike Serial 600 (SBKS600)	from 401 cc to 600 cc, fourstroke, four cylinder from 550cc to 675cc, three cylinder from 601 cc to 750 cc, fourstroke, two cylinder
Superbike Serial 1000 (SBKS1000)	from 601 cc to 1000 cc, fourstroke, four cylinder from 601 cc to 1300 cc, fourstroke, two cylinder

ENTRY FEE

*The entry fee for each race from the Eastern European road racing championship is **50 euro**. Every rider must pay the fee in order to participate in the event. The fee must be paid at the technical control.*

A rider who wants to participate in the Eastern European Road Racing championship, but he has a rider's licence issued by a federation that is not a member of BMU, must pay 500 euro entry fee per race in order to participate. The entry fee must be paid at the technical control.
