1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The **Road Racing Club z.s. and Automotodrom Brno a.s.** will organize the race of the 2022 SSP 300 European Cup, FIM Europe Alpe Adria Circuit Racing Championship, Czech International Championship and Slovak International Championship.

This meeting will take place from the **30**th **September** till **2**nd **of October 2022** at the AUTOMOTODROM BRNO circuit.

3. CIRCUIT

The Brno circuit is 5,403 km long, 15m width, 73,75m elevation, 6 left and 8 right corners. All races will be run clockwise. A drawing of the circuit is attached. Adress: Masarykův okruh 201 / 664 81 Ostrovačice. GPS: 49°12'15.570"N, 16°26'49.600"E

The competitors have to print the application form, sign it and deliver it to the organizer at the registration.

11. TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE INSPECTION, TRANSPONDERS, BOXES, PASSES

No rider or machine is permitted to participate in the practice unless he/it has passed the technical inspections which will be held according to this time schedule:

The gate of the BRNO circuit will be opened for the participants on 29th September 2022 (Thursday) from 19:00.

Transponders

Timing will be done using transponders. Transponders will be allocated at the administrative check against the rider's license (in case of loss or damage of the transponder, the rider will pay 6,750 CZK / 285 EUR).

Boxes

It is possible to rent a box for 4,000 CZK (175 EUR) / 1 day. The deposit for the key and equipment of the box is 2,000 CZK. In case of loss of the key or damage to the equipment of the box, this deposit will not be returned. Both fees are payable in cash. Box keys are available at the administrative check.

Personal and car passes

At the administrative checks each rider will receive max. **4** personal passes (<u>1x rider, 3x mechanic/company</u>) authorizing to the PIT LANE/GRID). Additional PIT LANE/GRID passes cannot be purchased. All passes must be worn visibly throughout the whole stay at the circuit.









12. PRACTISING

According to the timetable attached. It is strictly forbidden to ride on the course outside of the official or paid practice periods. All laps will be timed. The price for one paid practice is € 35. - including VAT. The maximum qualification time for the European Cup, AAIMC and national championships equals to the best time plus 15% (115%).

The races for all classes will be run according to the timetable (encl.). Time limit to complete the last lap is 5 minutes.

Saturday: Quick starting procedure: 1x sighting lap, 1x warm up lap, start (without escort on the grid). Entrance to the track behind box no. 27. Exit from the track after the race: after the checkered flag the riders will leave the track behind the first turn to the right, the exit from the track will be according to the instructions of the marshals.

Sunday: Standard starting procedure Entrance to the track behind box no. 27. Exit from the track after the race: after the checkered flag, the riders will ride one more lap, exit the track according to the instructions of the marshals.

The races for all classes will be run according to the timetable (encl.). Time limit to complete the last lap is 5 minutes. Starting grid:

Starting procedure at the races will be in accordance with the AARR 01.18.

The races will be held in any weather conditions.

The organizer of the event may cancel the race only in the case of force major.

14. PENALTIES

The maximum speed in the pit lane is 60 km/h. The speed in the pit lane will be supervised. Exceeding the speed limit will be penalized as follows: Anytime € 65,-. The penalty must be paid 30 minutes latest before the start of the resp. class; otherwise, the rider will be excluded. For pit lane – speeding during the start procedure and the race, the ride through penalty will be inflicted. In the case of a jump-start the ride through penalty will be inflicted.

15. PRIZES

First three (3) riders in each class will receive cups.

16. PRIZE-GIVING

The prize-giving ceremony will be held as follows:

Saturday - first three riders of each class are obliged to come to the podium after the end of the last race.

Sunday - first three riders of each class are obliged to come to the podium **immediately after the end** of their race.









17. PROTEST

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the FIM Europe Disciplinary and Arbitration Codes/ AARR Rules and be accompanied by a fee of € 350 for AA classes and € 350 for FIME class. The fee for an appeal against the decision of the Steward Panel, if the decision is another as the RD decision, follows the FIM Europe fees, is € 650 (see FIM Europe Disciplinary and Arbitration Code in its current version – to be found in FIME yearbook 2021).

18. FUEL

A fuel station is in the circuit paddock.

19. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for the entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the FIME requirements. In conformity with Article 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders covering accidents occurring during the meeting including practices will be the responsibility of the organizer. This insurance includes a guarantee of € 170.000. The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle(s), its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

20. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the FIME Sporting Code, riders and teams by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIME Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organizer, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.

21. MEDICAL TREATMENT

The Medical Centre is situated in the paddock. The organizer together with the Medical Service will take care for the necessary medical treatment. The CMO decides upon whether a rider is fit or not especially after each fall. Therefore, each rider must be checked after a fall by the CMO without any additional order. Otherwise, the rider will be excluded.

22. PROTECTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL

According to FMNR Environmental rules, the use of an environmental mat is compulsory. Each rider is responsible for his and his team's waste. Containers for waste must be used following their specification. It is strictly forbidden to leave any waste. Penalties against this will be in accordance with the Sporting Code. The organizer has the possibility to request all costs resulting of behavior against the Environmental Code of the FIM. It is forbidden to start competition bikes between 09:00 p.m. and 07:00 a.m.

23. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

These Supplementary regulations and they will strictly observe them. Modifications, additions and interpretations of these Supplementary regulations are under exclusive competence of the management of the race and the Jury. Participants (incl., but not only: competitors, riders, mechanics, guests, etc.) take part in event at their own risk. They carry sole civil and criminal legal responsibility for any damages or injury caused by them or the vehicle they are using.

Apart from the requirements of the Sporting Code FIM E, participants (incl., but not only: competitors, riders, mechanics, guests etc.) by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representatives or agents by arbitration of before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIME Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of organizer, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out their actions. The interpretation of these regulations' rests entirely with the Jury. In case of dispute, regarding interpretation or if there is any difference between the two official texts, the English text will prevail.

24. ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS

General organization in the paddock

Only teams and service cars of the participants of this event may be inside the paddock. Access to the paddock and pit area is possible from Thursday 29 September 2022 from 19:00. All vehicles must have appropriate car pass prominently displayed.









All vehicles that do not have a visibly placed car pass or will exceed the permitted time, or that will park on the road in the pit area will be towed. The fine for incorrect parking is 3,240 CZK / 135 EUR. It is forbidden to park on connecting and emergency roads in the paddock. It is necessary to follow the instructions of security.

Competitors are required to clear out the boxes and paddock area by Sunday, October 2. 2022 by 19:00. Competitors and all participants of the event must follow traffic signs and valid road traffic regulations in the area. Speed is limited to "walking speed" throughout the area.

In the boxes and in the safety zone behind boxes (up to the white line) it is forbidden to spend the night, smoke and handle open flames - e.g. grilling. It is strictly forbidden to operate catering services in the entire area of the Automotodrom. Compliance with this regulation will be checked during the event. If the competitor or other persons violate this regulation, they shall pay the organizer a contractual fine of up to 27,000 CZK / 1,100 EUR for each detected case immediately after receiving the first request for payment from the organizer.

Furthermore, the competitor is obliged to use water reasonably. It is strictly forbidden to turn on taps for no reason, to cool drinks under running water and to fill pools. If the competitor or other persons violate this regulation, they shall pay the organizer a contractual fine of up to 27,000 CZK / 1,000 EUR for each detected case immediately after receiving the first request for payment from the organizer.

Free movement of children under the age of 15 on roller skates, skateboards, bicycles, motorcycles and mini bikes is prohibited. Parents are responsible for their children. It is forbidden for dogs or other animals to run freely in the area. The owner of the animal or the person who brought the animal to the Automotodrom area is responsible for damages caused by non-compliance with this prohibition.

Any drilling (or other damage) into the asphalt is strictly prohibited under fine in all areas of the Automotodrom. Washing vehicles with gasoline or other solvents is prohibited. The surface of the paddock must not be damaged by oil, fuel or other liquids. All participants must maintain cleanliness and protect the environment from pollution, all garbage and used oil must be placed only in containers intended for this purpose. A space for pouring oils and other environmentally harmful substances and substrate is set up next to the technical check-in of riders. Violation of the ban on spilling these substances in other areas is fined 3,000 CZK / 125 EUR.

Furthermore, it is absolutely necessary to use an ecological absorbent mat when performing service work (with oil, petrol, coolant and brake fluid, etc.). The recommended size of the mat is at least 100 cm x 160 cm. Violation of these regulations is fined 3,000 CZK / 125 EUR for each offence.

25. **CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT**

Should circumstances or safety reasons demand it the event could be postponed or cancelled. For this the organizer cannot be held responsible.


