9. INSURANCE, ENTRIES AND STARTING PERMISSIONS

All riders must be authorized by their national federation (FMN) in order to participate in the event(s) via starting permission plus license confirmation (to be presented at the administrative control).

ALL STARTING PERMISSIONS FOR THE PARTICIPATING RIDERS MUST BE SENT UNTIL 22.09.2026 FOR TECHNICAL REASONS.

All riders must use the official AAIMC entry system for their entries for the event.

All entries must be sent minimum 2 days before the beginning of the Administrative control.

All riders will be required to sign additional documents at the Administrative control.

Riders under the age of 18 (minors) must be accompanied by a legal representative (parent or guardian) at the technical and Administrative control.

By signing and stamping the Starting permission for a rider, their FMN declares that the rider in question:

- has a valid insurance for motorcycling sports **valid for the territory of Bulgaria and for the days of the event** according to FIM Europe requirements
- has no bans or prohibitions that prevent them to participate in the event,
- is physically and mentally fit to participate in the event,

- has the sporting skills of the required level in order to participate in the event without endangering him or other participants during the event

The organizers disclaim all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

The organizers have contracted a third party insurance according the FIM Europe regulations for the days of the event (Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday) for the amount as stated in the BMU Regulations.

11. FREE PRACTICES, TIME PRACTICES AND RACES

Free practices, Timed Practices and Races will be run according to the timetable enclosed.

12. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Riders renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the BMU Regulations or the FIM Europe Sporting Code where applicable, for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organizer, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.

SPECIFIC AND ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR THE EVENT:

Additional Administrative regulations

- Entry to the circuit will be possible only with the corresponding passes received at the administrative control.
- Riders must come personally to the administrative control to sign documents, receive passes etc.
- Every rider can be accompanied by maximum 2 mechanics and 1 manager, for a total of 4 persons
- Trailers will not be allowed in the inner section of the paddock. A specific area of trailers shall be designated.
- Riders may remain in the Paddock on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings as security will be provided and in accordance with the current regulations of the circuit. The use of open fires (barbeques etc.) is not allowed for safety reasons.

- f) Riders are fully responsible for their behavior on the track and at the venue, as well as for their team members. The organizers cannot be held liable for any damage to property or material losses caused by riders/team members etc.
- g) Penalties shall be as follows:
- burnouts – forbidden anywhere in the venue / penalty is DSQ + 500 Euro + repair costs
 - damage on property (intentional)/ penalty is DSQ + 500 Euro + repair costs
 - smoking in the pitlane or boxes / penalty is 50 euro per occurrence
- All financial penalties are issued to the rider and are due for immediate payment. Riders with unpaid penalties shall not be allowed to continue their participation. Financial penalties, due to a rider and not paid during the event shall be transferred to their FMN.
- h) Boxes should be rented directly from AAIMC organization.

Additional Sporting regulations

- a) The penalty for jump starts during the races will be 10 seconds added to the total racing time.
- b) Sunday's grid positions in all classes will be based on the best lap time achieved during Saturday's races.
- c) In case a rider from F600/F1000 does not achieve the minimum required qualification time (110%), they might be moved to "F110" Group. No points and prizegiving foreseen for F110. Similar system can be implemented for SSP600 and SBK classes by decision of the RD.
