All entries must be sent minimum 2 days before the beginning of the Administrative control.

All riders will be required to sign additional documents at the Administrative control. Riders under the age of 18 (minors) must be accompanied by a legal representative (parent or guardian) at the technical and Administrative control.

By signing and stamping the Starting permission for a rider, their FMN declares that the rider in question:

- has a valid insurance for motorcycling sports according to FIM Europe requirements,
- has no bans or prohibitions that prevent them to participate in the event,
- is physically and mentally fit to participate in the event,
- has the sporting skills of the required level in order to participate in the event without endangering him or other participants during the event

The organizers disclaim all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

The organizers have contracted a third party insurance according the BMU regulations for the days of the event (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) for the amount of 20 000 euro.
