- Entry fee is 130€ paid on the administrative check
 - To participate a competitor must have competition license as follows: F.I.M. International License (Enduro or Cross-Country) or F.I.M.-Europe (Enduro Raid) or National (Enduro) annual or one event with starting permission.

Technical Conditions

The event complies with the FIM Europe – European Extreme Enduro Cup Regulations 2015. The motorcycles must be in very good technical condition. They must have functioning lights (headlamp, brake & rear lights) for safety and legal reason throughout the event.

The motorcycles must have Enduro/Motocross tires.

During the Race and after the registration, after finishing the track or the repairs (if needed), the motorcycles will be kept in the permanently guarded Park Ferme. The motorcycles can only be pushed in or out, engine not running. Access will be granted only with the competition badge.

Mandatory: The motorcycles must be in the Park-Ferme before the START of the race in all the legs of the event.

START

At the Prologue, the competitors will start according to their racing number. The results will be displayed on the Paddock notice-board.

Starting order Day 1: Based on the Prologue results.

Starting order Day 2: Based on the results of Day 1

The start of the competition will end 15 minutes after the last competitor has started the race. Those who are not on the starting line right on time, will start at the end, after the last competitor has started.

Penalties

Missing a Check Point or not stopping in one shall be penalized with at least 100 minutes. If a motorcycle is not in the Park-Ferme before the start, the penalty is +20 minutes.

Disqualifications

- Smoking in the Park – Ferme and the refueling spots
- Refueling with engine running
- Changing motorbike during the event
- Riding in opposite direction to the course.

RANKING

There are no special stages, each day is one stage. The penalty times (if any) are added to the total time of each competitor thus determining the classification, the shortest time taking first place, the second shortest second place, and so on. General classification will be generated after regulations of the European Extreme Enduro Cup by adding the times and penalties of Days 1 & 2. In the event of a tie, the points are given to the rider with the best time on the last day of the event.

The provisional results will be displayed less than 60 minutes after the closure of the track, and then there will be a 30 minutes time limit for protest and appeals. If there not any, then the provisional results become final without any further notice.

Protests must be submitted no later than 30' after the arrival of the last competitor if the protest is against a rider or a motorbike.

Appeals will be addressed and solved by the Race Director together with the BMU officials. The appeals shall be made in writing and a fee equal to the entry fee must be paid, to be returned in case the appeal is granted.

Withdrawal

In case of withdrawal, it is imperative that it is announced to the Clerk of the Course and the Jury. If you don't announce your withdrawal/abandonment, there will be search operations the cost of which will be paid by the competitor.

Competitors that withdraw in one leg may compete in the next, given the time of the last competitor of the leg they abandoned + 200 minutes.

Prizes & Awards

Cups will be awarded to the first three for the Prologue.

Cups for places 1, 2 & 3 and medals for places 4, 5 & 6 of the General Classification
